This invitation is given to every FAI affiliated National Aero Club (National Airsport Control Organization) to enter their team (three senior and three junior competitors from every country, one team manager and one assistant team manager) and also to the senior individual world champions 2017, as well as those junior world champion who are entitled to participate according to the provisions of CIAM General Rules, paragraph C.5.3 d. Supporters, helpers and spectators are also invited to attend. Further information is going to be announced in Bulletin 2.

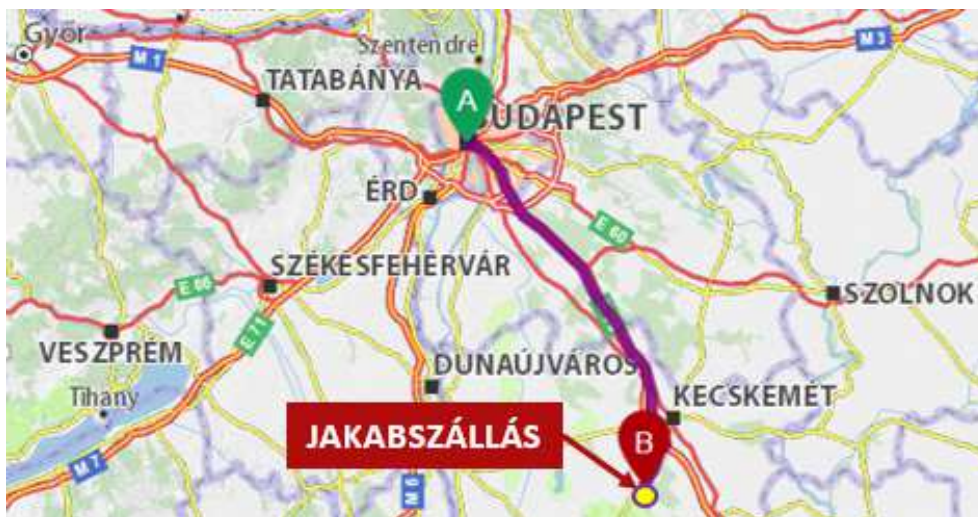

HOW TO REACH JAKABSZÁLLÁS

By flight to Budapest Liszt Ferenc Airport and continue by car to Kecskemét on M5 motorway. From Kecskemét Road 54 has to be used to reach Jakabszállás.

- Easy accessibility (Budapest International Airport, M5 highway)
- Budapest – Jakabszállás: 102 km (~1 hour by car)
- M5 highway - Jakabszállás: 18 km

Official languages are English and Hungarian.

NATIONAL TEAM:

Each member of the FAI-CIAM may enter a team consisting of:

- team manager
- assistant team manager
- maximum 3 competitors senior
- maximum 3 competitors junior - age limit 18 years in the year 2019
- according to the FAI Sporting Code, the reigning senior World Champion 2017
- according to the FAI Sporting Code, the reigning junior World Champion 2017 (referring to the CIAM General Rule 2019; sections C.5.1 and C.5.3. d)
- official helpers, supporters

FAI SPORTING LICENSE

Each competitor and team manager must possess a FAI Sporting License valid for 2019. This license must be registered in the FAI licenses database.

ALLOWED FREQUENCIES

35 MHz, 40 MHz, 2.4 GHz. Organiser strongly recommends 2,4 GHz.

TIMEKEEPERS

Organizers will provide local timekeepers.

RESULTS

The results will be posted on scoreboards at the flying field during the competitions and will also be available on the website.

AWARDS

FAI diplomas and FAI medals will be awarded for first, second and third placed pilots (both senior and junior).

First, second and third team (both junior and senior teams including team manager) will be awarded with FAI diplomas and FAI medals.

Following FAI perpetual trophies will be awarded to the winners:

- Senior individual (current holder is Vincent Merlijn - NLD)
- Senior team (current holder is Germany)
- Junior individual (current holder is Tiaan Van Rooyen - RSA)
- Junior team (current holder is Israel).

ENTRY FEE

Senior competitors – 300 EUR;
Junior competitors – 150 EUR;
Team manager – 300 EUR
Team manager's assistant – 200 EUR;

BANQUET

Banquet fee is 50 EUR.

PROTEST

Any protest must be presented in written form in English to the Contest Director and must be accompanied by the deposit of 50 EUR. The deposit is returned only if the protest is upheld.

PAYMENTS

The entry fee payment deadline is 15th April 2019.

After the entry deadline (from 15th April till 15th May 2019) a penalty of 20 % shall be paid.

Entry fees paid after 15th May 2019 will be rejected.

REGISTRATION

Each team manager shall bring for the registration:

FAI certificates for the models entered.

Document in copy regarding the transfer of entry fees.

TRAINING

Training is possible on 11th July 2019 using the whole flying site. After this date competitors will have the chance for training only on the designated training area.

ANTI-DOPING

Competitors taking for medical reasons, any of the substances listed on the WADA Prohibited List must have a valid Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) certificate from FAI.

INSURANCE

The organizer provides the same third party insurance for all competitors which is valid for the members of the Hungarian Association of Modellers.

All the team members and visitors must have their own health insurance to cover illness and accidents.

MEDICAL SERVICE

During the competitions medical service will be ensured at the flying field.

VISA

Please check the necessity of visa to enter Hungary. In case you need letter of invitation **to support your visa, please, do not hesitate to let us know.**

WEATHER

The average temperature during the competition days in the recent years were within 24–28°C. The average wind speed is approximately 1-3 m/s. Heavy rains are rarely possible. Please, for any case, take with you warm cloth and raincoat.

MEAL

Food and drinks will be organized on a daily basis at the flying field. Meals will be available in Aero Hotel and there will be buffets on different points of the field.

REFRESHING AREA

Organizers will provide an optional refreshing area with separated blocks for each team if required. (It is an optional choice, not mandatory). The aim of this area is to give a place for the participants where they can have a rest, prepare or fix the models. It is a common covered place, where a buffet will be available to get some refreshments during the whole time of the competition.

The cost for “renting” a block in the refreshing area for the whole period of the competition is 20 EUR/team – regardless of the number of the team members.

ELECTRICITY

For electrical appliances and charging equipment, the electric network in Hungary operates on 220 Volts / 50 Hz.

ENTRY DEADLINE

The arrival deadline of the Preliminary Entry Form is 15th January 2019, even if the entry fees will be paid later.

Applications will be published on the web site of the World Championships.

The Preliminary Entry Form is attached to this Bulletin (see Annex).

COST CALCULATION PER PERSON (contains: entry fee, banquet, accommodation, meals)

300 EUR + 50 EUR + 20 EUR/day (=140 EUR) + 15 EUR/day (=105 EUR)
