

# FAI European Flying Scale Models Championship - 2005

## POMBAL - PORTUGAL

28th August to 4th September

### TRANSFER ADVICES

When you arrive at Portela Airport – Lisbon, you may take a taxi, out of the exit lounge, the arrival lounge.

You may ask to the driver to take you to the Orient Station, in Portuguese “Estação do Oriente“, about 2 Km going down straight to the river “Tejo”.

The maximum cost of the race should be about 3,50 euros. You may tip if you wish. The Orient Station is a very beautiful and modern structure, built in concrete, with a bus, a subway and a railway station, with a Shopping Centre in front of it.

The Shopping Centre “Vasco da Gama“ has restaurants and all kind of commerce, cinemas, etc., and is integrated in the place where took place, in 1998, the last World Exhibition of the XX century: “Lisbon - Expo 98“.

The railways station, Orient Station, has the ticket office in the first floor and the train stops in the second floor.

At the ticket office you ask for a ticket to POMBAL – second class, that costs 11 euros for the normal train and 14 euros for the “Alfa Pendular” train. Just choose the option and the time of your convenience.

On the web page of the European Championships, you can get the time table of the trains to Pombal.

If you have time take a walk along the river in the “Park of Nations”, just on the other side of the shopping centre Vasco da Gama, between this one and the river.

Please take a look at the local map.

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If you come to Lisboa by plane and you want to rent a car and drive to Pombal, take note of the following.

You have all rent-a-car offices in the arrival lounge. Be sure to have a valid credit card.

When you leave the airport with your car you will see some directions and you must follow **A1- Norte** High Way. You can see the high way about two hundred meters from the Arrival Terminal, looking down south to the river “Tejo” and the access is made by driving in that direction and turning left just under the viaduct.

Then you will drive about 156 km and must leave the A1 when you see the exit to Pombal.
